Dosage and Instructions

Spray Bottle – add one drop of SUPERthrive for every 4 oz of water.

Hose-End Sprayer, Siphon Mixer/Proportioner, Backpack Sprayer, or Tank Sprayer – follow the manufacturer's instructions to achieve the 1/4 tsp. per gallon ratio.

NUTRITION WHEN YOU NEED IT

Foliar spray is a great short-term fix for plants suffering from nutritional deficiency. This is because plants absorb nutrients more quickly through their leaves. The vitamins and nutrients in SUPERthrive help plants make the most of this process.

When using this application method, spray plants in the morning before the sun is too hot and make sure to spray both sides of the leaves. Like many gardeners you can also add a surfactant to the mix, so that moisture will remain on the leaf long enough for the nutrition to be absorbed.

Be aware that some plants, like roses and tomatoes, are fussy about getting water on their leaves. When spraying these plants, make sure that they have time to dry before the end of the day.

Tip: Spray your SUPERthrive mixture directly onto tomato blossoms and not onto the leaves!
